

## Kayne Anderson MLP Investment Company Completes Private Placement of Senior Notes and Preferred Stock

Houston, TX – November 10, 2010 – Kayne Anderson MLP Investment Company (the “Company”) (NYSE: KYN) announced today that it has completed a private placement with institutional investors of \$140 million of senior unsecured notes (the “Senior Notes”) and \$50 million of mandatory redeemable preferred stock (the “MRPS”).

Net proceeds from the offerings will be used to repay borrowings under the Company’s revolving credit facility, to make new portfolio investments and for general corporate purposes.
