ANNOUNCES ITS NET ASSET VALUE AT MARCH 31, 2007**

LOS ANGELES, CA – April 3, 2007 – Kayne Anderson MLP Investment Company (the “Company”) (NYSE: KYN), today announced its net asset value at March 31, 2007.

At March 31, 2007, the Company’s net assets were \$1.2 billion and its net asset value per share was \$32.38, based on 38.3 million shares outstanding.
